## NEW ILO REPORT ON WORK LIFE BALANCE

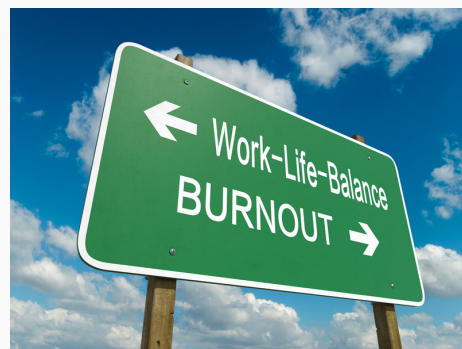

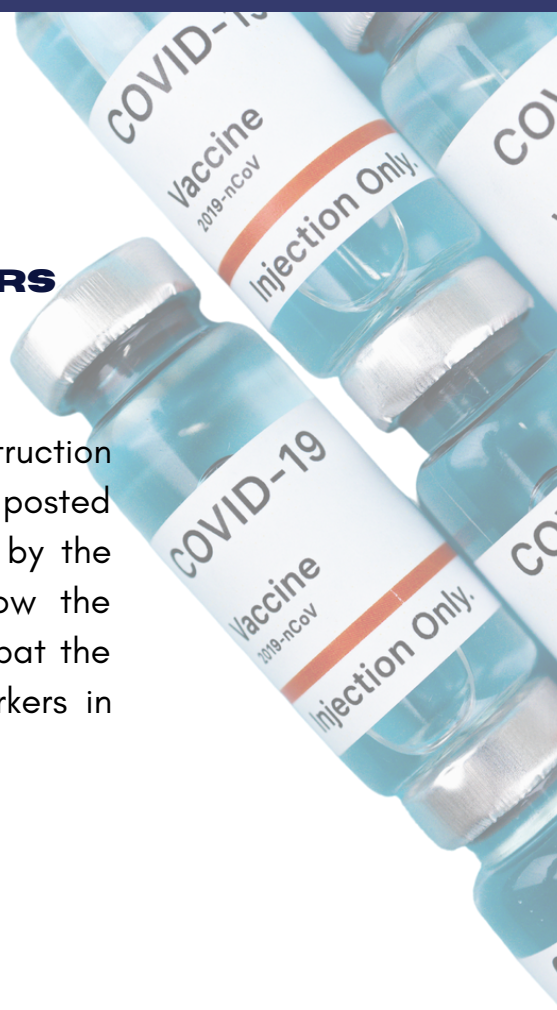
